<u>Description of Collection System & Treatment Process:</u>

The Town of Stantonsburg wastewater collection system consists of approximately 8 miles of sewer pipe which flows to the Town's two lift stations, or travels by means of gravity through said sewer pipe to the wastewater treatment facility located just off Peacock Bridge Road.

The wastewater treatment facility has a permitted discharge rating of .375-million-gallon daily average and treats by means of a draft tube extended aerobic oxidation ditch, a separate secondary clarifier, aerobic digester, and UV disinfection.

The wastewater treatment facility is rated as Grade II treatment facility, and discharges treated wastewater into nearby Contentnea Creek. The wastewater treatment plant also produces residuals or a sludge by-product that is land applied by Granville Farms, Inc.'s at their permitted facility. The Town completed construction of its Wastewater Treatment Improvements Project Phase I in the fall of 2014. This project consisted of the construction of a mechanical bar screen, secondary clarifier, sludge pumping station, intermediate pumping station, effluent Parshall Flume for flow measurement, ultraviolet disinfection system, cascade post aeration and installation of electrical generator.

I. Performance:

Text Summary of System Performance for the Fiscal Year 2024-2025:

The Town's wastewater collection system encountered relatively few problems during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, except for Hurricane Debby. During the rain event from the remnants of Hurricane Debby, over 6 inches of rain fell over the Town. This caused high flow amounts through the Town's collection system and WWTP. A Sanitary Sewer Overflow (SSO) occurred at the Town's Main Lift station (Lift Station #1) and a treatment bypass at the WWTP on August 8th, 2024. Both incidents were reported to NCDEQ and neither resulted in any violations. Both Town's Lift Stations are visited seven days a week, with preventive maintenance performed monthly. Over 7000 linear feet of sanitary sewer lines were cleaned, and numerous manhole covers were resealed.

The Town's Wastewater Treatment Plant operated with only minor issues apart from the reported Bypass mentioned above.

The Town's WWTP did receive two permit violations for fecal coliform during the month of April 2025. The violation was quickly addressed by staff.
